Brief of the Two Councils

- As per Local Government Act, Councils responsible for leadership that adopts principles of ESD & social justice in providing equitable services & facilities for the community. Includes planning & development matters.
- EP&A Act also imposes obligations to assist in project assessment.
- S 355 allows Councils to delegate certain functions but accountability and probity requirements remain same.

Two Elements Requiring Proponent Funding

1. Infrastructure Upgrade Component:

- Upfront funding for infrastructure where Epuron has liability or makes direct demand on infrastructure, eg roads
- Akin to S 94 matters
- Councils have provided scope of work for road upgrade study to determine baseline & ensure upgrades required are implemented

Two Elements Requiring Proponent Funding (Contin)

2. Contributions for Public Benefit Aspects:

- Funding for works/activities that add a broader public benefit & may include intangibles
- Includes a social responsibility element
- Annual contribution + CPI

Suggested Allocation of Public Project Funds

- recreational & sports facilities, community facilities, drainage structures, environmental protection, streetscape & other public domain improvements
- Road Maintenance Fund
 allocated to project related roads

View of the Two Councils

- Ensure environmental, social & economic benefits of Proposal outweigh costs & deliver outcomes as per Community Strategic Plans.
- Councils hold the funds. Have a S 355 Committee make recommendations to Council as to funding allocations. Benefits of this approach:
 - optimises accountability & transparency of financial management
 - recognises the broad, community wide influence of project
- S 355 Committee option supported by DP&E
