Development Update

- DP&E deemed the EA adequate for public exhibition on 7 July.
- DP&E publicly exhibiting the EA from 1 August to 1 October (62 days).
- EA submissions must reach DP&E by COB Wednesday 1 October.
- Project newsletter No 11 released in August.
- Community Open Days held in Coolah and Cassilis on 8 & 9 September respectively.
- The RET review report was released on 28 August.
- Project consists of 288 wind turbines.
- New overhead powerline connection at existing Ulan 330kV transmission network.
- Remaining landowner arrangements nearing completion.
- Consultation feedback continue to inform the project layout.

RET Review Report


- The Panel considered various options for reforming the Large-scale Renewable Energy Target. These include:
 1. extending the target to achieve a 'real 30%' share of generation by 2030
 2. reducing the target to achieve a 'real 20%' share of generation in 2020
 3. setting a target that corresponds to a '50% share of new growth' in electricity demand
 4. closing the LRET to new entrants' and
 5. 'repealing' the LRET scheme.
- The objectives of the RET are to:
 - encourage the additional generation of electricity from renewable sources;
 - reduce greenhouse gas emissions in the electricity sector; and
 - ensure that renewable energy sources are ecologically sustainable.
 - Current target is 20% renewables by 2020 (41,000GWh)

- Establishment of a Community Enhancement Fund
 - Further thoughts on required community support and preferred delivery model
- Proposal for a combined business meeting in Cassilis
- CCC intention to make a submission to exhibited EA
